Prophets: Moses (3:22), David (2:25-31), Joel (2:16-21), Isaiah (8:28-30 & 28:25),

Agabus (11:28 & 21:10), Samuel & all OT prophets (3:24), Judas & Silas (15:32)

High Priests: Annas, Caiaphas, John, Alexander, Ananias (4:6)

<u>Jewish groups</u>: Pharisees & Sadducees(23:1-6), Zealots(1:13), Rulers, elders, scribes (4:5)

Jews from various places: Parthians, Medes, Elamites, residents in Mesopotamia & Cappadocia

the Ethiopian Eunuch (court official for Queen Candace--converted by Philip 8:26-40)

Lydda-Aeneas (healed by Peter 9:33)

Joppa-Tabitha (Dorcas-raised from the dead by Peter 9:36)

Cyprus-Sergius Paulus (proconsul 13:7)

Lystra-Timothy (fellow worker with Paul 16:1)

Philippi-Lydia (1st convert in Philippi) Jailer (16:23-40)

Athens-Dyonysius, the Areopagite & Dammaris (17:34)

Corinth-Aquila & Priscilla (18:2), Titius Justus, Crispus, Sosthenes

Ephesus-Apollos 18:24, 12 disciples--rebaptized 19:1-7, Artimas, Gaius, Aristarchus, Alexander Troas-Eutychus (raised from the dead 20:9-10)

Centurions: Cornelius (Roman centurion converted by Peter--the 1st Gentile disciple Ch 10)
Claudius Lysias (rescued Paul from Jews & refered him to Felix 23:26-35)

Julius (transported Paul to Rome 27:1)

Pr.ocurators: Pilate (condemned Jesus 4:27), Felix(Ch 24) & Festus(Ch 25) (Paul's judges)

H.erods: The Great (built the Praetorium in Caesarea & other structures 23:35)-ancestor to these:
Antipas(friend to Pilate4:27); Agrippa I (killed James 12:1-2); Agrippa II (heard Paul 26:1)
