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# The Exodus -- 2<sup>nd</sup> to Creation

## **The Greatest Event of the OT!**

*Over 100 references to the Exodus in the N.T.*

- **Ch 1-19**

- Persecution of God's people – Ex 1-6
- Plagues upon Egypt – Ex 7-12
- Passage from Egypt to Sinai -- Ex 13-19

- **Ch 20-40**

- Declaration of Commands – 20-40
- Instruction on the Tabernacle – 25-31
- Defection of the Golden Calf – 32-34
- Erection of the Tabernacle – 35-40



# The Book of Redemption

- Key word: **DELIVER!**
- Key expression: **“As the Lord commanded Moses.”**
- Key verse: Ex 3:8
- *“So, I have come down to deliver them from the power of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and spacious land, to a land flowing with milk and honey.”*

# Key Verses:

- Ex 12:50-51 *“And on that same day the LORD brought the sons of Israel out of the land of Egypt.”*
  - **God’s grace** is revealed in redemption
- Ex 40:34-35 *“Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.”*
  - **God’s glory** is manifested in worship!

# Prophecy of Moses


- **Deut 18:18-20** *“I will raise up a prophet from among their countrymen like you, and I will put My words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. It shall come about that whoever will not listen to My words which he shall speak in My name, I Myself will require it of him.”*
- **Why so important?**
  - John 1:21 **John the Baptist.** Are you “the prophet?”
  - Key way to **convert Jews!** See **Acts 7:37**

## • EGYPT

- 40 years
- Student

Acts 7:22 "Moses was ***educated in all the learning of the Egyptians . . .***"

## • MIDIAN

- 40 Years
- Shepherd
- II Cor 12:9 "My ***power is perfected in weakness.***"

# Last Stage of the Life of Moses

- **Wilderness for 40 years**
- Savior & Shepherd Acts 7:25 “God was granting them deliverance through him.”
- 2 Cor 8:9 “He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you through His poverty you might become rich.”



# Foreshadowing of Christ in Moses

## (Acts 7:37)

- Born in humble circumstances (Ex 1:13-14)
- Raised in Egypt (Ex 1:1, 2:3)
- Survived an attempt at infanticide (Ex 1:22)
- Initially rejected by the people they save (Ex 2:14).
- Went 40 days without food/water (Ex 34:28)
- Delivers people from bondage (Ex 14:26-31)
- Spoke to God face to face (Ex 33:11).

# Foreshadowing of Christ in Moses

## (Acts 7:37)

- Introduced the law of God (Ex 19:17).
- Became intercessor/High Priest (Ex 19:8).
- Introduced us to God (Ex 19:17).
- Entered the most holy place (Ex 25:22).
- Made a covenant in blood (Ex 24:6-8).
- Established the tabernacle/church (Ex 40:17-33)
- Humbled and then exalted/judge (Ex 19:9)
- Great patience and forgiveness (Ex 32:32)
- meekest man on the face of the earth (Num 12:3)

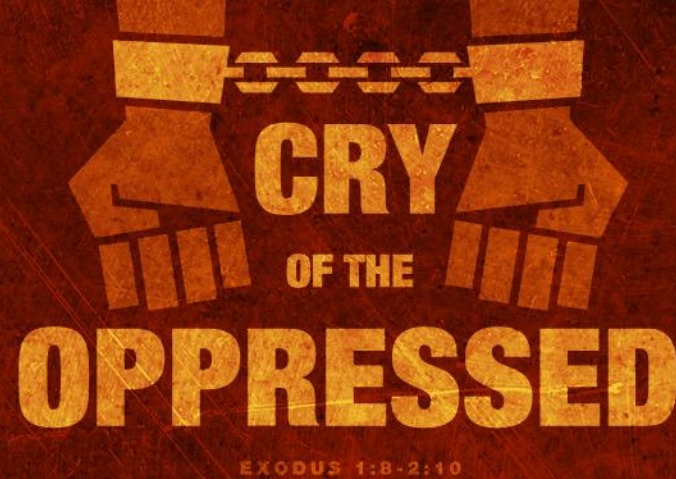

## Excuses of Moses (Ex 3:11-4:1-15)

#1: Who Am I? Why me? (3:11)

Answer: "I will be with you!"

#2: Whom Shall I say sent me? (3:13)

Answer: Tell them, "*The I am that I am*"  
sent you! Jehovah the God of your  
fathers.



# The Call (Ex 3:1-10) and

## Excuses of Moses (Ex 3:11-4:1-15)

#3: They won't believe me! (4:1)

Answer: God Gave Moses *two*  
*miraculous signs.*

#4: I'm not an eloquent speaker! (4:10)

Answer: Who made your mouth?

#5: Send someone else (4:13).

God is angry. I will let Aaron be your  
spokesperson. He will be glad in heart!

PROPHECY: 4:21 “I WILL HARDEN HIS HEART AND HE WILL NOT LET THE PEOPLE GO.”

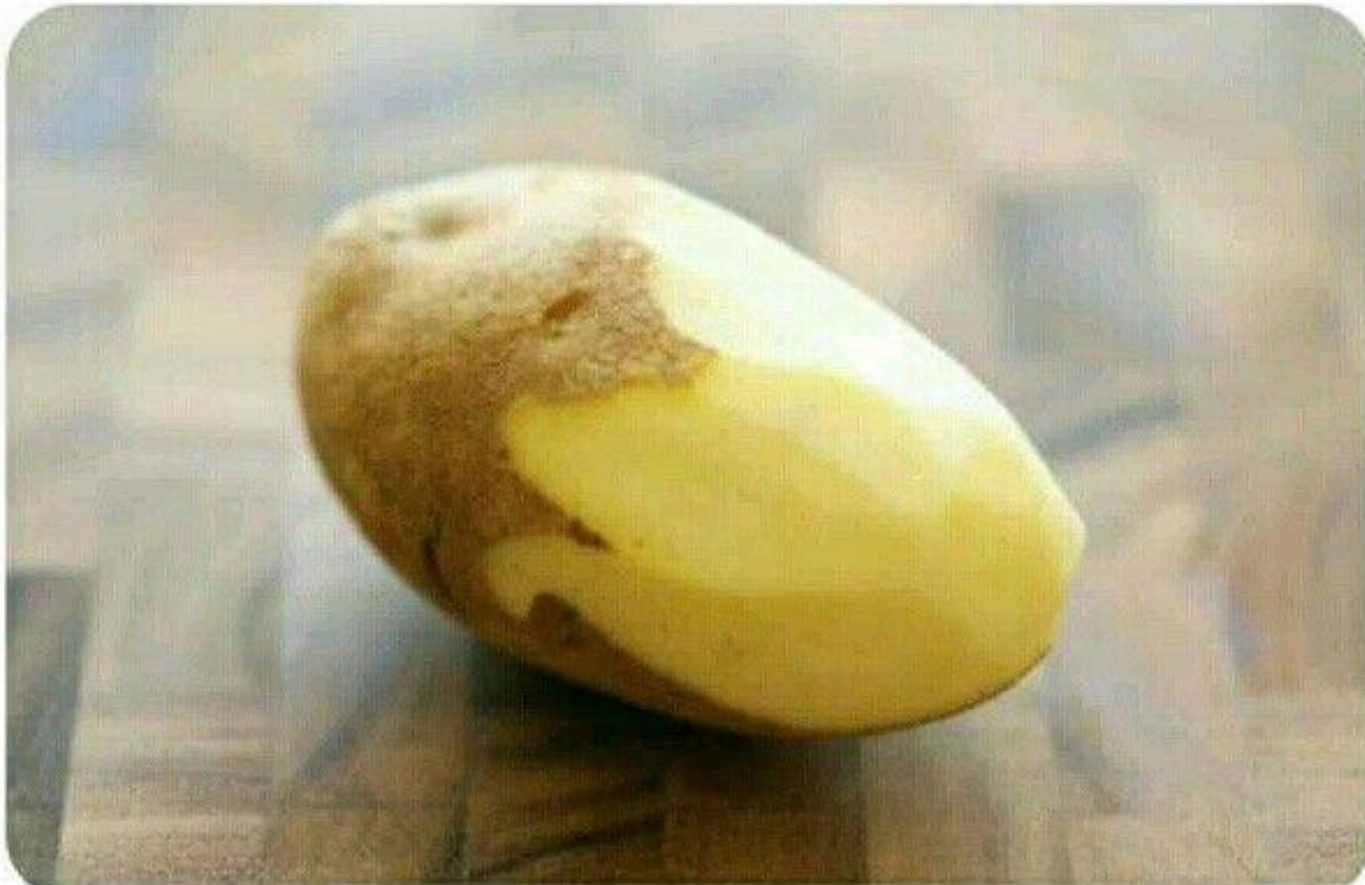

# The Hardening of Pharaoh's Heart

- Pharaoh was stubborn before it is said that God hardened his heart (Ex. 2:23; 3:9,10; 5:2).
- Note the comment on this incident by the Philistines in 1 Sam. 6:6. Pharaoh was hardened just like Sihon King of Heshbon and others (Deut. 2:30; see also Josh. 11:20).



- God provides the circumstances for hardening to those who do not want to obey God (Ezek. 20:25-26; Rom. 1:24,26,28; 2 Thess. 2:10-11; 2 Cor. 4:4).
