B. Paul frequently prayed that he might "speak the word with all boldness (Eph 6:20). "
C. Boldness is a part of the NT pattern that needs to be restored today, especially in this day of political correctness.
I. WHAT IS BOLDNESS?
A. "Daring, courageous, brave, and f "
B. "A willingness to overstep usual bounds of propriety."
C. "To speak plainly and without ambiguity."
II. EXAMPLES OF BOLDNESS.
A. Peter & John. "For we cannot help but s " (Acts 4:20).
B. Paul & Barnabas. "Paul and Barnabas waxed b " (Acts 13:20).
C. Paul (Acts 19:8, Acts 14:3, I Thess 2:2-4, I Cor 4:9-14, Acts 17:16ff).
III. HOW CAN WE DEVELOP AND INCREASE BOLDNESS?
A. The way we meet p
B. Be willing to talk with anyone about what needs to be said.
C. Talk with intensity and passion the way the apostles did.
D. Realize boldness is NOT just for the y and the restless.
E. It is not just about p , but making sure you are right.
F. P for it. It is the most common prayer request of Paul.
G. G into it. Seek the company of bold people!
