Scripture Reading: I Timothy 3: 1-7, Titus 1: 5-9

Intro.

- A. Today, we will look at the **special qualifications** of an elder.
- B. These are things not required of all Christians, but must be present if one is to be qualified to serve as an elder.

I. MUST BE A MAN (I Tim 3:1-2, 4-5; Titus 1:6).

- A. Husband of one wife (andra = man, husband).
- B. Be head of his own house and $\mathbf{r}_{\underline{}}$ it well (Eph 5:22-23, I Tim 2:12).

II. MUST NOT BE A NOVICE (I Tim 3:6). Not a new convert.

- A. Not to be a neophyte, or "newly planted."
- B. Danger of appointing the novice is the possibility of **p**______.

III. MUST DESIRE THE OFFICE (I Tim 3:6).

- A. Desire: "To stretch forward." Also used in Heb 11:16.
- B. "To set one's heart on, to long for."

IV. MUST BE THE HUSBAND OF ONE WIFE (I Tim 3:2, Titus 1:6).

- A. Must be married, married to a woman, & be a *one-woman man*!
- B. Can a widower meet these qualifications?

V. MUST HAVE FAITHFUL CHILDREN IN SUBJECTION (Titus 1:6, I Tim 3:4).

- A. Must have his own family and have children.
- B. Must have believing (faithful) children. Most logical answer = Christians.
- C. His children must be in **s**_____.

VI. MUST RULE HIS OWN HOUSE WELL (I Tim 3:4-5).

- A. Leadership qualities must be present and demonstrated at home.
- B. He must be the **h**_____ of his home (Eph 5: 22-23, 6:4).

VII. MUST BE ESPECIALLY CAPABLE WITH THE WORD (I Tim 3:2, Titus 1:9).

- A. Must be "apt to teach" and "able to **c**_____ the gainsaver."
- B. Requires knowledge of the word, skillfulness (2 Tim 2:15; Heb 5:13-14).
- C. Ties in very closely with feeding (pastoring) the flock (I Peter 5:2).

Study and pray about these qualifications and be part of helping to select **H**______ Spirit appointed elders (Acts 20:28)!
