Supporting the work and reputation of My Church and committing to spiritual growth

Attending faithfully*, giving regularly, and living a godly life; growing though personal Bible study, prayer and by regular fellowship and edification with fellow members.

*Take advantage of worship, class, and our CARE small group opportunities. The elders care for the flock and so if a member is missing several weeks without any advance "head's up" notice (ie. travel, vacations, sick, etc.), we'll check in to see if everything is okay.
