Thesis:

- Key principles
- Six-point plan for spiritual restoration



- We must not stop until the job is complete!
 - -We have not "arrived" (Jude 3).
 - -Plenty of work to do!
 - No room for complacency (Hebrews 6:1). Press on!

"Those who become disciples of the discoverers soon become the enemies of discovery."

- True Restoration is three fold:
 - Congregational
 - Generational
 - Personal
 - We stand before God as individuals—not as congregations.
 - Each of us shall give account of himself to God (Rm 14:12)

"We are just one generation away from apostasy."

- Real Genuine Spiritual Restoration
 - -Take a stand against apathy, externalism, worldliness...
 - -Yield oneself to God and His will
 - -Avoid: 2 Tim 3:5 "form without power"
 - -Have a real sense of God's presence -Acts 4:24;29, 31-32a; 33.
 - -True revival is God's work (Ephesians 3:20)
 - Die to self and let God work!

Six Points of the Second Restoration

Rediscover Personal Spirituality

Daily relationship with God

Understanding that Spiritual Satisfaction Is Not Found Simply in Doctrinal Orthodoxy


- It is important to be correct.
