

## What is the "New Atheism?"



Theodicy = "The defense of God's goodness and omnipotence in view of the existence of evil."

# WHY DID GOD ALLOW THE POSSIBILITY OF





Premise 1: God is *omnipotent*, so He has the power to eliminate suffering.


Premise 2: God is *good*, so He has the desire to eliminate suffering.

Premise 3: The World = suffering!

Con: An omnipotent, good God does not exist!

#### What is the Answer?

- "If the premises are true, the conclusion is definitely true.
- Therefore, belief in an omnipotent, good God is "positively irrational."

- One easy way is to deny that God is good.
- Another is to deny God is omnipotent.





Premise 1: God is *omnipotent*, so He has the power to eliminate suffering.

- Yes, He does!
- But He may have a morally good reason why He does not intervene.





## Premise 2: God is *good*, so He has the desire to eliminate suffering.

- Yes, that is the reason for the garden of Eden and heaven.
- God intends to produce a <u>greater</u> good that requires Him to permit evil and suffering.





#### Premise 3: The World = suffering!

- True, but some of it is necessary.
- Most is caused by sin and not by God.

## Con: An omnipotent, good God does not exist?

- This conclusion no longer follows!

"God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them." NASU



#### Genesis 1:27-28

#### A part of God's image = Free will.





It is <u>free will</u>, not God, that makes possible all the moral evil in the world (Ecc 7:29)!

#### Why is Free Will so important?

- Humans are a <u>special creation</u> (Ps 8:5).
- It is necessary for a love relationship.
- It is necessary for <u>human development</u> and <u>learning</u>.
- It is a necessary prerequisite for <u>virtue</u>.
- Free will is what makes us human!





Premise 1: God is omnipotent, so He has the power to eliminate suffering.

- Yes, but He may have a morally good reason why He does not intervene.
- To create a world without the possibility of moral evil would take away free will.


#### The Meaning of Omnipotence

- Omnipotence means "all powerful" ...
  but that does not mean the power to do
   anything.
- Somethings are nonsensical and a contradiction of terms.



#### The Meaning of Omnipotence


- Somethings are against God's nature (Heb 6:18).
- Was there a way to save man from sin without Jesus having to suffer and die?




#### Things God can't do. God can't:

- Get tired or grow weary (Isaiah 40:28).
- Take on a job He can't handle (Jer 32:17).
- Be unholy (Isa 6:3).
- Be prejudiced (Acts 10: 34-35).
- Break a promise (Ps 89: 34).
- Abandon you (Deut 31:6).
- Stop thinking about you (Ps 139: 17-18).
- Stop loving you (Jer 31:3).

#### A Classic Puzzle

- THE ANSWER IS NO.
  - God has unlimited power, so there
    is no stone He can't lift, therefore it
    is impossible to make one He could
    not lift.
  - This is not a refutation of His omnipotence; it is the result of His omnipotence.

#### The Ultimate question...

- Could an omnipotent God create a world with <u>free will</u> but <u>no evil</u>?
  - NO!
  - "God can create free creatures, but He cannot cause or force them to do only what is right. For if He does so then they are not free."
