"Do not be afraid, nor dismayed, arise and go" (Joshua 1:2, 8:1).







Why did the Israelites not leave the body of the king of Ai on the tree overnight?

While still in the wilderness, God had long ago commanded the Israelites that they were not to leave the body of an executed person on a tree after sunset (Deuteronomy 21:22-23).



What events occurred in the book of Genesis around Bethel and Ai?

Abram had pitched his tent between Bethel and Ai on 2 occasions and built an altar there; it was where Abram and Lot parted ways.

Jacob had slept there and saw his vision of angels ascending and descending a ladder; God had told him in the vision that the land would someday belong to his descendants.

It was the place to which Jacob and his family fled after his sons had massacred Shechem.



Briefly describe the ceremony that took place at Mount Ebal & Mount Gerizim.

First they built an altar of uncut stones and offered sacrifices. Then they took large stones and plastered them and then wrote the law on them. Then the people were divided into 2 camps (by tribe), one against Mount Ebal and the other against Mount Gerizim. The Levites would pronounce blessings and curses for various actions and the people were to answer, "Amen".



How many curses were stated by the Levites? What were the blessings that they declared?

There were 12 curses that are listed in Deuteronomy 27.

We do not have a record of the blessings.

What significant event in Israel's history occurred at Shechem (Genesis 12:4-7)?

This is where God appeared to Abram and first promised the land of Canaan to his offspring.
