#### I. THE BIBLE IS FULL OF PERSONAL SALVATION ACCOUNTS

- "I will tell what He has done for my soul"(Ps 66:16).
- Many **b**\_\_\_\_\_ in Him because of the woman's testimony (John 4:39).
- "We cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard (Acts 4:20).
- Jesus said "we testify to what we have seen" (John 3:10-11).
- "Make known amount the nations what He has done" (Ps 105:1).

#### II. THE VALUE OF YOUR PERSONAL SPIRITUAL JOURNEY

- Unique: No other pathway to God exactly like yours.
- P**\_\_\_\_\_: You can share from your heart.
- 100% yours: You are the greatest authority on your own experience.
- M**\_\_\_\_\_: People love to hear personal stories and they remember them.
- Relational: People connect with experiences.
- Effective: People will be impressed when they see scriptural evidence.
  - "Always be prepared to give an answer" (I Peter 3:15).
  - "The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God" (Romans 8:16).

- How I realized I **n**\_\_\_\_\_ Christ.
- How I committed my life to Christ.
- The difference it has made in my life.
