<ul> <li>A. The word <b>Jubilee</b> is a Hebrew term for joy and <b>c</b></li> <li>B. It occurred every fifty years and was looked forward to with great anticipation.</li> <li>C. It happened on the <i>Yom Kippor</i> – The day of <b>a</b>!</li> </ul>
I. THE YEAR OF JUBILEE
A. It was a year to fully trust in God.
1. They were forbidden to <b>p</b> or sow the land and had to trust in God to provide (Lev 25: 11).
2. It was difficult, but God said He would provide for them abundantly (Lev 25: 18-22).
B. It was a year of <u>renewed blessing</u> .
1. Every man who had lost his tribal inheritance got it returned to his family as originally given (Lev 25: 13).
2. This was true <b>d</b> forgiveness, even if one could not afford to pay it back it was returned (Lev 25: 28), Provided a clean slate.
C. It was a year of mercy among brethren.
1. Those who had placed themselves as indentured <b>s</b> were set free even if insufficient time had elapsed (Lev 25: 39-43).
2. Can you see the love and sacrifice made in God's name?
II. THE AGE OF JUBILEE and "The favorable year of the Lord."
A. It would begin on the day our sins are <b>f</b> (Acts 2:38).
B. It would be an age of fully trusting in God (Rom 5:8-11).
C. It would be an age of renewed <b>b</b> (Eph 2:1-7).
D. It would be an age of <b>m</b> among God's people (Gal 5: 1, 13).
