B. EVIL SPEAKING (Eph 4:29;31).
1. Def: "Words that tend to h"
2. May be t, yet still wrong!
3. "Judge not according to appearances but judge <i>righteous</i> judgment" (John 7:24).
C. FAULT-FINDING (Matt 7:1-5).
1. Def: Harsh, caustic, vindictive criticism"
