E. **FOOLISH TALKING** “(Eph 5:4). “Fruitless discussions.”

F. **HARSH WORDS** -- “A g\_\_\_\_\_ answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger” (Prov 15:1).

G. **LYING** “Speaking f\_\_\_\_\_hoods knowingly.”

H. **MEDDLER or BUSYBODY** - “A p\_\_\_\_\_ into others affairs.”

I. **REVILLING** -- “To speak reproachfully; rail against.”

J. **TALEBEARING** - “An informant; a disloyal b\_\_\_\_\_.”
