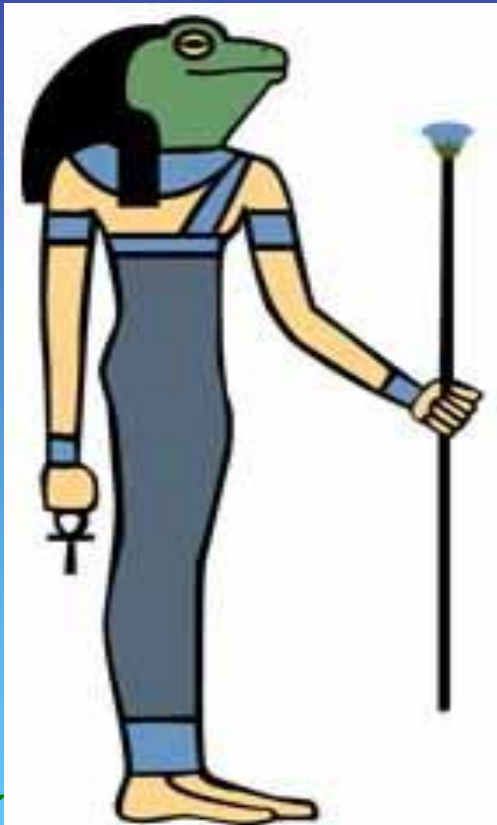

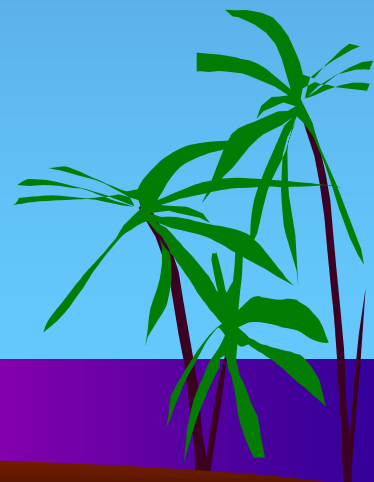

# The Frogs got to Pharaoh

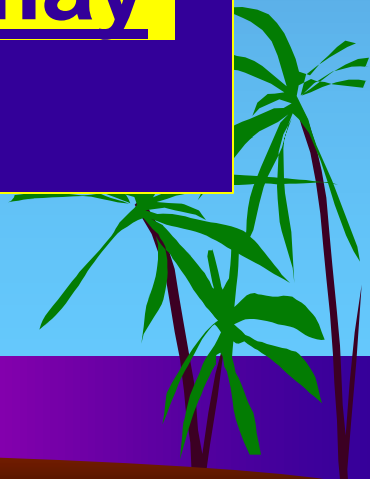
8. Pharaoh said: “Entreat the LORD that He **remove the frogs from me and from my people**; and I will let the people go, that they may sacrifice to the LORD.”





# Most Amazing . . Ex 8: 9-10

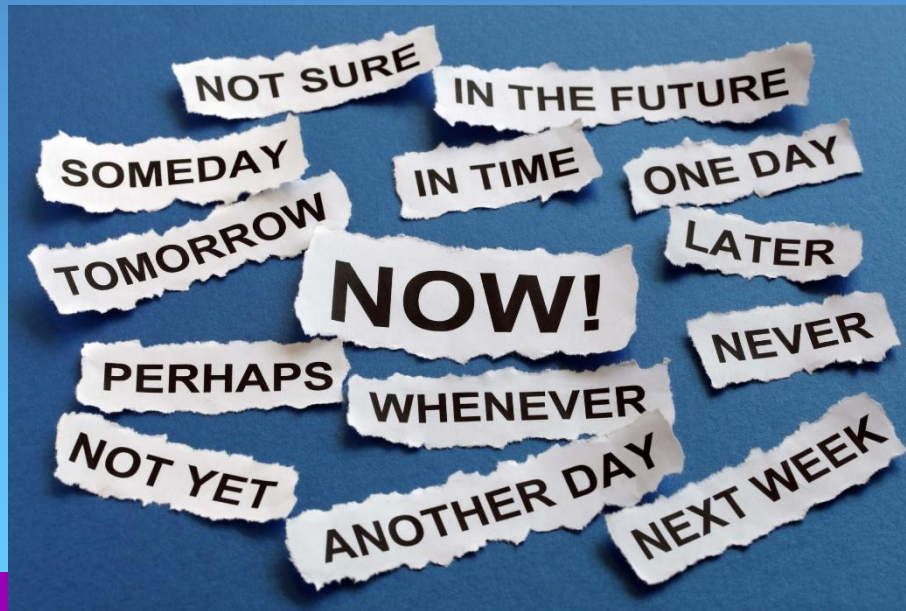

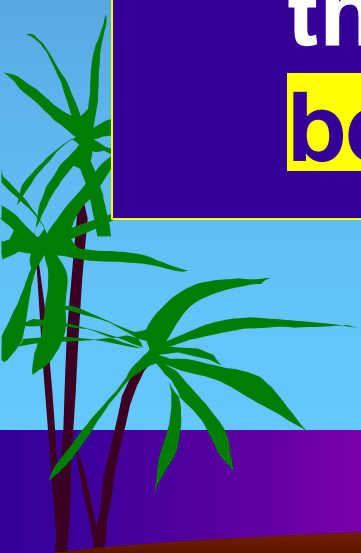
# Procrastination: There is *always* Tomorrow!

# Procrastination is a Thief

- It robs us of our *opportunities* to do RIGHT!
  - Lk 8:12: “.. then the devil **comes and takes away the word** from their heart, so that they will **not believe and be saved.**”





# Felix and Paul

## Acts 24:25

25 But as he was discussing righteousness, self-control and the judgment to come, Felix became frightened (**trembled; terrified**) and said:

"Go away for the present, and when I find a more convenient time, I will summon you."

# Why be frightened?

- Felix believed!!
- “*Convinced but not converted.*”
- Secular History says Felix never found “a more convenient season.”

- Tomorrow is *always* *(not only)* **a day away.**



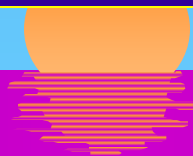
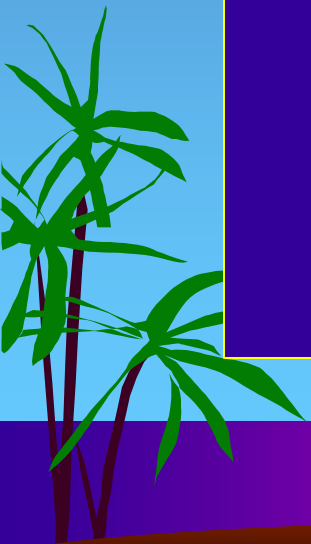
No one lives in the day called
