#### Hero #1- Job



- Job is renown for PATIENCE.
- "In all this, Job did not sin with his lips" (Job 2:10).
- "Job cursed his day ..." (Job 3:1).

>>> I A M E S 3:8




"I lay my hand upon my mouth" (Job 40:4)

#### Hero #2- Moses



- Moses is known for MEEKNESS.
  - -Num 12:13 "Above all the men which were upon the face of the earth..."
  - -What happened?
    - "They provoked his spirit, so that he spoke unadvisedly with his lips" (Ps 106:33).





- Y SO IMPORTANT?
  - Deals with the HEART!

### Definition: Slanderer!






#### #4. SLANDER – Mk 7:22

- Lit: "Words of *falsehood* spread with *malicious intent*."
- "Speaks truth in his heart and does not slander with his tongue" (Ps 15:2-3).
- "He who spreads slander is a fool" (Prov 10:18)!



- #5. BACKBITING Rom 1:28-30
  - "God gave them over to a <u>debased mind</u>, being filled with <u>unrighteousness</u> ..they are whisperers, <u>backbiters</u>, <u>haters of God</u>"

(Rom 1:30)!





- #5. BACKBITING Rom 1:28-30
  - Lit: "To <u>speak against someone</u>, especially in their <u>absence</u>."
    - 2 Cor 12:20-21 "I fear ... find you backbiting."



  - O.T.: Lev 24:14 "Whosoever blasphemes ... shall be stoned."
  - N.T. Col 3:8-9 "Put off these things: anger, malice, blasphemy...

- #7. BOASTING:
  - Rom 1:30, Prov 27:2.
  - Opposite of love I Cor 13: 4b.
  - "Boast in the Lord" Jeremiah 9:23.
- #8. CURSING Jas 3:10
  - Profanity "treating sacred things as common."
  - Ex 20:7, Heb 12:16, 2 Tim 2:16.



- #9. FILTHY SPEECH Col 3:8.
  - Prov 6:12 "A wicked person walks with a perverse mouth."
- #10. JESTING NOT BEFITTING
  - Eph 5:4 "coarse jesting."
