- To become selfish
- To become immoral
- To be foolish and lose your soul, your heart, your salvation.

III.- Without the divine helmet, our thoughts are lost and far from GOD.

NKJ Isaiah 55:7-9

7 Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the LORD,

And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.

8 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the LORD.

9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts.

When you repent from your sins confessing Jesus is the Son of GOD and are baptized, and your sins are forgiven, when the gift of the Spirit creates a temple in your heart receiving the promises of salvation and eternal life, then you put on the divine helmet which is given to you by GOD.
