Apostacy and anarchy go together.


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*“The church is most effective when it

# God Gives Nations the Leaders They Deserve

*Do men make the times, or do the times make the men?*

- As Israel declined so did the judges.
  - Who was the worst?
    - Abimelech “the bramble king.”
    - Samson – strong but weak spiritually.
  - Gideon, Jephthah, etc. did acts of faith but provided *no enduring leadership*.

# The Golden Age of David was a notable exception.

When the righteous rule, the people rejoice; when the wicked rule, the people groan.

# God still blesses those who live by faith

Faith is not believing in spite of evidence (this is superstition) but obeying in spite of the consequences.

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We must stand with God even when we feel *alone*, or *afraid*.

God honors even weak faith and seeks to make it stronger. (Similar to strengthening a muscle).

# God story isn't finished yet

Judges is depressing, but it isn't the end of the story!

Six OT books begin with: “Now it came to pass”/or “as it was.” Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 2 Samuel, Esther, Ezekiel. Why?

Because it all a part of a *continuing story!*


Judges is the book of “no king” –  
2 Samuel = God's King. (David).

The gospels are books of the *second David*, the real chosen one (Messiah coming the first time)!

RUTH 1:1-18

- WHY?

- **Love story!** Joyful ending! Literary masterpiece.
- **Romance of Redemption!**
  - Begins with tragic *funerals* – ends with *joyful wedding!*
  - Begins with terrible famine – ends with fullness.
  - Goes from *bitterness to sweetness!*
  - Shows how faith & loyalty to God = **joy and blessing!**
- Only woman = “*worthy woman*” (Ruth 3:11).

- **WHEN DOES IT TAKE PLACE?**
  - Fascinating history. (Judges)

- **Period of the Judges.**
  - Judges 21:25 -- *“In those days there was no king in Israel.”*
  - Elimelech’s name:
    - “God is my King!”
    - **God is a God of *individuals*.**

- **ANOTHER REASON WHY?**
  - Critical element in **Messianic line**.
  - What is the significance of Obed?
    - Obed is the father of Jesse, who is the father of David (Ruth 4:17).

- Two books named after women.
- Five women = Genealogy of Jesus.
  - Tamar
  - Rahab – mother of whom?
  - Bathsheba
  - Ruth
  - Mary


- **WHY? Prophetic Types**
  - Hos 12:10 “I have also spoken by the prophets, and I have multiplied visions, and used **similitudes**, by the ministry of the prophets. KJV
  - Models, Types, ***Foreshadowing!***
  - Boaz is a type of Christ!

# Names in Ruth

- Boaz – “In Him is my strength.”
- Ruth – “Beauty or Desirable.”
- Elimelech – “God is my King.”
- Naomi – “Pleasant”    Mara – “Bitter.”
- Orpah – “Fawn”

# What does Oprah Winfrey have to do with Ruth?

- She was supposed to be "Orpah" Winfrey, named for the Biblical Ruth's sister-in-law, but the name was spelled wrong on her birth certificate, and soon everyone was calling her Oprah.




# Names in Ruth
